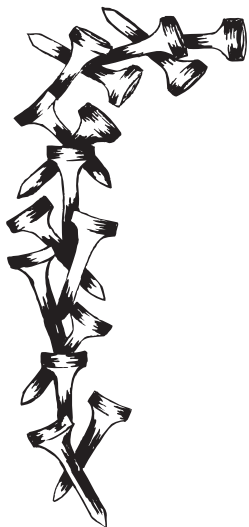

11 Brandon Barrows Rochester Adams Dan Picot

Brandon has been on varsity for three years. As a junior Brandon lead our team to the Oakland County Championship. He averaged a 74.1 in his junior season and was top medalist four times; in fact he finished in the top five in every tournament he played in 2014. Brandon is well respected by his teammates. He is a leader in his community by giving his time to special needs students who take an interest in the game of golf. Recognized by the AJGA as an outstanding leader in sportsmanship, Brandon continues to work on his game and giving back to the game he loves. As a member of the Rochester Adams golf program, we could not be prouder of his accomplishments.

Nick Carlson had a rough start to his season injuring his wrist at his first tournament of the year. Once healthy enough to play, Nick was back to his usual form. He was tops at the OK Green Conference with a 35.83 scoring average. Shot an even par 72 at Conference at Macatawa Legends in less than ideal conditions. He was medalist at the Forest Hills Invitational at Egypt Valley with a two under 71/71 total 142. He was also medalist at the MHSAA Districts played at Clearbrook Golf Course posting a 3 under par 69. Again he was medalist at the MHSAA Regionals at Cedar Chase Golf Course this time posting a 3 under par 69. Nick finish runner up at the MHSAA State Finals played on Forest Akers West carding a 2 over par 75/71 totaling a 146. Nick has now been a member of the Super Team for three straight years. He also has been named to the Grand Rapids Press All Area Team for the third time. Nick is an impressive young man.

Austin finished his high school career just the way he always had dreamed, a MHSAA Division II State Golf Champion. He has always been one of the hardest working players both on and off the golf course. He finished 11th in the state his freshman year and shot 74-74 to help his team at states, but he wasn't satisfied. His sophomore year the team did not advance and he lost in a 3 hole sudden death playoff individually to advance to States at the Pohlcat. This was the point he committed to work harder than ever and Austin and I began to fine tune his game. In his junior season his team did not advance but Austin played well and advanced to the finals at The Meadows in Grand Rapids finishing 4th, one step closer towards his goal. In his final season he not only advanced but was medalist at

Districts, Regionals and finally medalists at States played at Michigan State University. He shot 72-72 to win the Division II Men's Golf Championship. Austin became the school's third individual state champion in Croswell-Lexington High School history and the first in golf. Coach Fabbri said "It has been both a privilege and an honor to coach such a committed and, driven athlete." Austin received a scholarship to McKendree University a Division II college in Illinois.

He had the best scoring average in the OK Red Conference with a 9-hole average of 37.7 and was named to the OK Red All-Conference Team. Out of the eleven 18-hole events he played, he was in the top ten every time. His season highlights include: a 3rd place finish at the Kent County Classic posting a 74, Tied 4th at the Zeeland East Invite with a 76, and tied 2nd in the OK Red Mid-Season Conference tournament with a 76. He took 3rd in the Seaholm Invitational played at Oakland Hills Country Club with a score of 75 on the South Course. He had another 2nd place in the Rockford Spring Classic with a 74 and won the Rockford Varsity Invitational with a 71. He won the OK Red Post Season event with a 71 and took 4th at the 36-hole Forest Hills Invite with an impressive 152. His overall average this year was 74.47. He led the Rams to a 3rd place finish at States, Regional Title, District Title, and Conference Title and helped win the Kent County Classic, Zeeland East Invite, Rockford Spring Classic, Rockford Varsity Invite, Forest Hills Invite and 2nd in the prestigious Seaholm Invite. Rams overall record was 165-4. Joel was named All Conference, All-Area 1st team and Super Team. Joel's hard work in the classroom and on the golf course, along with his positive attitude brought him to this level.

Max shot a sizzling 144 in the two-day Traverse City Tee-Off at The Wolverine and Spruce Run. Max carded 72's at Districts, where he won Medalist honors, and at Regionals. Max ended his high school career by shooting 75-68 at the Division 1 State Finals and finished 9th overall. Coach Ten Eyck is quick to point out that what makes Max so successful as a golfer is his determination and work ethic. Max is always the first to arrive and last to leave from practice. Max was honored as a Division 1 All-State Team Member after his freshman and sophomore seasons. He will be playing golf at South Alabama University in the fall.

She competed in 12 18-hole tournaments, winning medalist honors an amazing 9 times, with two second place finishes while compiling a scoring average of 72.5 per 18 holes. Elayna won tournaments all over the state. Too mention a few. . . She won both days of the Traverse City Lober Classic (76/71), The Patriot Cup at the Fortress (72), the WWAC League tournament (72), and the Division 1 MHSAA Regional at Sanctuary Lake (74). Elayna posted an unbelievable season that rewrote the Dearborn High School record book. This season, Elayna shot par or better seven times and accumulated what Coach Inch calls THE BIG 50, with 3 eagles and 47 birdies over her 17 playing dates – an average of 3 per round! Elayna did not begin to golf competitively until her freshman year in high school. She began high school shooting around 100 and then proceeded to set every school golf record at Dearborn High. I have never seen anyone work so hard and improve so quickly in high school golf. Coach Barkoff agree Elayna work ethic and determination are what sets her apart. Her hard work paid off and made her one of the best golfers Dearborn has ever known. Regardless of all of these individual accomplishments, Elayna may have been happier with her team’s third straight trip to the MHSAA State Finals and Dearborn High’s first ever Girls Regional Championship. Her leadership by example not only helped her improve, but also helped create a great team, as her team set records for tournaments won(4), low score(320), low 9-hole score(166), and the MHSAA Regional title. Elayna also excel in the classroom as a 4 year Academic Award letter winner, 2-year member of the National Honor Society member, with an impressive overall GPA. Elayna is committed to study Business Management at the Loyola University Chicago where she will be a member of the Ramblers golf team. She also was medalist in 4 out of 8 Invitationals, and finished 2nd twice and 3rd twice, including an amazing 5 under par 67 at Lilac Golf Course in the Monroe Jefferson Invitational and a 2 under par 70 in The Monroe County Championship at Carrington Golf Course and led the team as repeat champions in both of those events. Jaclyn's 9 hole scoring average was 37.5 and her 18 hole scoring average was 75.5, both new scoring records at Monroe, and was selected for her 3rd time (Freshman and Sophomore years at SMCC Monroe) as Monroe County Player of the Year.

That support has allowed his girls to do the work necessary to build a winning tradition. Dan's wife Jackie has also worked side by side with him since he began coaching the girls in 2007. He has always measured his team's success by the number of girls he has in the program, and by the number we can teach to compete successfully. Over 75% of the South Lyon girls who come out for the golf team have never played golf before. He and his wife make themselves available to the girls year round to help them get ready for competitive golf. South Lyon girls have won their league championship the past two years, and the MHSAA Regional Tournament for the past three years. The girls have also played in the State Finals for the past six years. The 2014 season was a great season for Dan's team. They were undefeated in 11 dual matches using three different varsity squads. 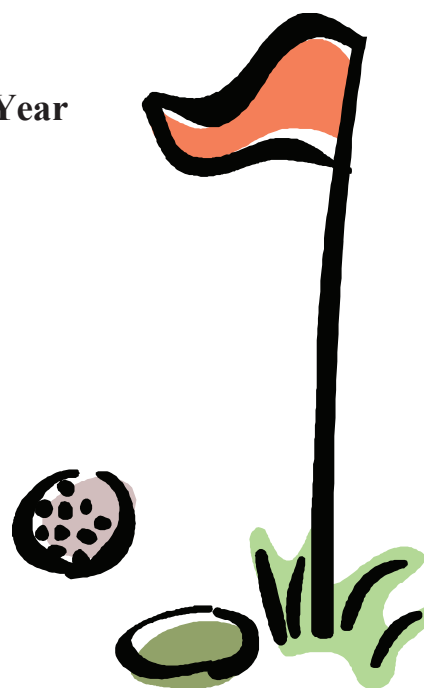

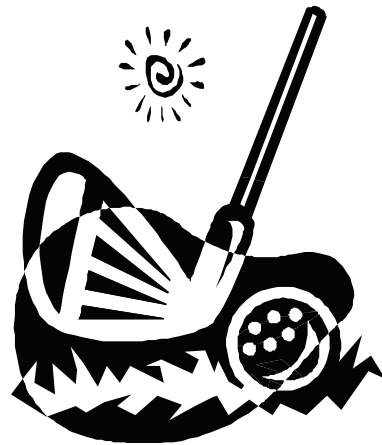
