12 **Jimmy Dales Northville Chris Cronin** Jimmy Dales stands as one of Northville High school's all-time most decorated athletes. A three-sport varsity athlete at Northville, Jimmy participated in Tennis, Hockey, and Golf. During his career as a Mustang, he earned 10 varsity letters and helped his teams reach the State Finals an amazing seven times. Additionally, Jimmy earned All-State honors in both Hockey and Golf. As a senior, Jimmy was honored as Northville High School's Athlete of the Year. Jimmy signed with the University of Wyoming to play Division I golf in the fall of his senior year. During his senior spring campaign with Northville, Jimmy had one of the best seasons ever recorded by a Mustang golfer. His scoring average was 72.5, and he was tournament medalist at the both the KLAA and Region 3 Championships. Jimmy would go on to The Meadows at Grand Valley State University, and finish with a two-day total of 143 (1 under par) and in a tie with Patrick Sullivan of Grosse Pointe South. Sullivan would prevail on the second playoff hole. Jimmy played his final five 18-hole rounds of high school golf in 5 under par. Jimmy is one of the fiercest competitors I have had the privilege of couching. His passion and dedication to the sport make him a consummate role model for young players. As a member at Meadowbrook Country Club, Jimmy would often finish practicing with his team and then drive twenty minutes to the club, only to put in another three hours before calling it a night. As a coach, I admired not only Jimmy's leadership as a senior captain but his quiet confidence that helped set the tone for the rest of the team.



Charlie DeLong **DeWitt** Dave Koenigsknecht Charlie had an amazing junior year for DeWitt High School. He started of the season with an excellent 69 and continued to play well all year as we have come to expect from such a talented player. In his third season on the varsity Charlie averaged an incredible 70.8 for his 18 hole rounds and 36 for his 9 hole matches. He played the entire season at 14 strokes under par! He won five tournaments and finished in the top seven in every event he competed in. He shot in the 60s four times including an amazing 64 in our conference tournament at Hawk Hollow. He finished second in the Regional and fourth in the Division 2 State Finals with rounds of 71 and 72. Charlie is a very hard worker, spending many hours hitting balls indoors during the winter months. Obviously that hard work has paid off for him. In light of his success on the course, Charlie has remained a very humble and polite young man. He is a leader on our team and an excellent student as well, maintaining a very high GPA. Charlie was named the Lansing State Journal Player of the Year and will continue his golf at the college level at Grand Valley State University. They are lucky to have him, as we are at DeWitt High School for one more year. Congratulations Charlie!





11 Erik Fahlen NorthPointe Christian

Erik started playing golf at a very young age and met many of his school competitors at the age of 8 when he started playing in tournaments. As a freshmen he had the lowest average on the team and he drove the older players on the team to play better because they didn't want to get beat by this little freshman golfer. His freshman year his team finished 4th in the state. Erik's sophomore year he won four invitationals and earned first team all-state. But in the state finals the team took second place and he finished 11th individually. They were so close but had to settle for the state runner up. That just didn't do. Erik wanted to get better and he wanted a win for the team. In Erik's junior year, he focused entirely on golf instead of being a multi sport athlete. In Florida he also played several tournaments against very good golf academy kids. In the off season Erik was always preparing for the next tournament. He learned how to finish and for the first time started shooting in the 60's for tournament rounds. Out of 19 tournaments he was the medalist 5 times and had 13 top tens. He learned to grind it out on the days you didn't feel like playing or the breaks weren't going your way. In the 2018 high school season, Erik started out with a win in the Kent County Classic playing against several allstate players from all divisions in the Grand Rapids area. He also shot a 68 at the Meadows for medalist at the OK Silver Conference tournament and was medalist at the Mona Shores invitational against a very good field. The most important thing on Erik's mind was helping the team win the state championship. After finishing 4th and then 2nd the past two years, he wanted a victory for his team, especially his all-state team mates, Logan Holtkamp and Hayden VanErmen. Erik, Logan and Hayden had pushed each other to get better the past three years. The team finished strong and NorthPointe shot 299-296=595 and won the State Title by 33 shots. Erik fired rounds of 71-67=138. That score set a record for the lowest ever division 4 state finals total and it is the 4th lowest of all time in all divisions. All the time, practice & hard work paid off to achieve that goal!

12 Thomas Hursey Suttons Bay Todd Hursey

Thomas started his High School Golf career by helping Suttons Bay win the 2015 State Championship at The Meadows. He followed his Freshman Season by earning Honorable Mention All-State as a Sophomore. In his Junior season, he finished 8th individually at the State Finals which led to First Team All-State honors. Thomas was Student Council President and National Honor Society Vice President. He was the Elementary School Mentor Program Director and an MHSAA Scholar-Athlete Finalist. He earned 12 Varsity Letters and was Captain of 6 of those teams while carrying a very high GPA. Thomas earned All State awards in Basketball his Sophomore, Junior and Senior seasons. He finished his High School Basketball career with 1190 points as he broke school records in 3 point shooting. Thomas capped off his stellar Prep career by averaging 72.2 in tournaments on his way to winning 12 of the 17 events he competed in. Some highlights of his senior season include a school record six under 66 at The Heathlands and 6 other tournaments with a score of 71 or less. He won the Terry Thompson Invitational with a 71 and the Regional Title at the Grand Traverse Resort Wolverine Course with a 75. Thomas finished his High School career with a 67-74 (141) at the State Finals at Forest Akers East. This score is tied for the 6th best in State Finals history for Division 4. Thomas accepted a Golf Scholarship to Ferris State University where he will pursue a degree in Optometry.





11 Alex Jordan Mason Kirk Petee

Alex Jordan's mission to win a Division 2 state title his junior year actually started on the last hole he played his sophomore season at the 2017 division 2 regional competition held at The Emerald golf course. When Alex walked up to the tee box on his final hole, which happened to be the 12th hole, a 206-yard par three, he was only four over par and had put together one of his best rounds of golf that season. Playing into the wind Alex knew that he would have to make his best swing to insure his golf ball made it anywhere near the flagstick on that blustery day in St. Johns. Unfortunately, Alex did not execute the swing he desired and his golf ball struck the trees just left of the green and his golf ball ended up in a deep ravine with no real shot at the flagstick. A miraculous up and down would surely save the day but unfortunately this final hole would not end as planned. A double bogie on hole 12 would solidify Alex's score that day, 78. What was the final score to qualify for the state tournament that day? 77. Rather than walk away defeated and lost Alex Jordan walked off the golf course that day with his head held up high because he had already told himself something that only he truly believed - that he would win a state title. He did not know when or how but he truly believed that by mastering his skills and believing in himself that he would put himself in a position to one day stand at the top of the podium. Nor would the road to the state finals be easy. Alex would have to learn how to win throughout the 2018 season by competing against a fellow super team member, Charlie Delong, whom is also a member of the CAAC Red league and future Grand Valley State University teammate. Alex will truly say that the best competition only brings out your very best. Even though we are here today to celebrate the individual accomplishments of so many great golfers we should not forget what kind of teammate Alex Jordan is and his desire to make everyone around him better. Whether it be on the soccer field, the basketball court, or the golf course, Alex Jordan only wants one thing - for his teammates to share the stage with him. 11 Pierce Morrissey Big Rapids Mark Posey

Pierce Morrissey didn't start off his year the way he had expected. A basketball injury in late February sidelined him for his first 2 months of his junior golf season. Knowing he couldn't hit a golf ball for 8 weeks, Pierce took on the role of player/ coach and started working on developing his teammates that he would need for a run at a state championship. The Cardinal were coming off a 3rd and 2nd place finish at their last 2 State Finals and winning a state title has always been on the top of Pierces list of priorities. So, it wasn't easy watching from the gallery at a few early tournaments but he knew he needed to be patient and let his body heal and give his teammates a chance to develop. It wasn't until the last week in April that he dared get back to golf. With only a few days of practice and a brace to support his injury, Pierce fired a 2 under par in the teams first conference tournament. A few days later in the Traverse City 2 Day Invite he shot a 72-73 to win the tournament in cold and blustery conditions. But a few too many days of practice and playing caused his injury to return. With it, a loss of confidence and a few uncharacteristic rounds of poor golf, and he would need to learn to take it a little easier on his injury. Pierce was eventually able to put his struggles behind him and get back to playing the type of golf he is capable of and leading his team to a few victories. He won the Katke Classic 2 Day tournament on his home course by shooting 73-71 for an even par 144. He took top honors again at the Traverse City Invite and was the Most Outstanding Player of the CSAA for the 3rd year in a row. He continued his run with a 2under par 70 in the Regional at Willow Wood GC, helping his team to the Regional Championship. The Cardinals were ready to improve upon last year's runner up finish. They were tasked with finding a way to solve Forest Akers West. On day 1, Pierce came out firing and shot another 2 under par 70. It helped the team to a day 1 tie. On day 2 in some difficult winds and rain, Pierce posted a 77 and the Cardinals would again tie for the lead but lose the state championship on a 5th player tie-breaker. Pierce's two day total of 147 would earn him a bittersweet Individual Division 3 State Championship. Knowing Pierce, he will continue to demonstrate his tenacity for himself and his team.



12 Colin Sikkenga Kalamazoo Christian **Brian Seifert** Colin had a great season of golf for Kalamazoo Christian High School in 2018. Colin was all conference in the Southwest Athletic Conference for the fourth year and all-conference player of the year for the fourth year in a row. Colin was the 2018 regional medalist and lead his team to a first place finish at regionals. Colin placed 3rd individually this year at the state tournament and was on the all state team for his fourth year in a row. This is Colin's fourth year all state team award, second year on the MICGA Super Team and was named academic all state honorable mention for all his hard work in the classroom. Colin's scoring average this season for 9 hole events was 36 and his average for 18 hole events was 72. Colin shot 69 at Tullymore and was the medalist at the Big Rapids Invite. Colin shot 67 the Kalamazoo Country Club and was the medalist at the Hackett Invite. These are simple highlights to a great season. Colin is also more than golf. Colin graduated in the top 10 in his class academically and is off to be a student athlete at Oakland University after winning their academic and athletic scholarship. Colin received multiple scholarships and was voted as the top male athlete at Kalamazoo Christian. So much of what and who Colin is as person is tied into an underlying grit that most people don't possess. When things don't work in his favor on the golf course, the grit shows up and makes him better. He is motivated to succeed even when the breaks go against him. This will serve Colin well as he moves through life on and off the golf course.



12 **Patrick Sullivan Grosse Pointe South Robert McIntyre** Patrick Sullivan, is a determined and passionate competitor. His work ethic and dedication has afforded him many accolades over his four year high school career, and has allowed him to fulfill his goal of playing Division I golf for the University of Michigan. Over the course of his high school golfing career, Patrick Sullivan has been ranked first in the state of Michigan (2017, 2018), was named to the Macomb Area Conference All-Academic Team and the Michigan All-State Team (2017, 2018), awarded the Detroit Free Press Boys High School Golfer of the Year (2018), and has earned him numerous Regional medalist honors and District championships. In the culmination of his high school career, team captain Sullivan and the Blue Devils golf team won the Division I State Championships (2018) after two years of back-to-back runner-up team finishes. Individually, Patrick earned the medalist honors title at the Division I State Championships (2018) in a two-hole playoff. On winning the Team State Championship team after two years of coming second place rankings, Patrick stated that winning an individual title was a nice bonus, but the real bonus was taking the team championship title. In addition to many top 10 tournament finishes, he earned medalist honors in stroke play (2017), and most recently, he earned the title of Michigan Junior State Ametuer champion (2018). Patrick has spent the greater part of his life playing golf alongside his father, Tom Sullivan. His father's passion for the game influenced Patrick's interest in golf, and inspired him to work to become the golfer he is today. 

Throughout the season, Charlotte had 5 Medalist finishes which included the top spot in the Genesee County and Flint Metro League tournaments, the Patriots Cup at the Fortress and the Davison Invitational. As she worked her way through the season she also managed to set 4 new school individual records at Fenton High School which included setting new 9 and 18 hole averages, a new 9 hole low score with a 3 under 33 and new low 18 hole score with a 3 under 69. To be chosen the best high school player in the state in your sport is an honor. To be chosen a second time is incredible. To have it done three times is historic. That is the legacy of Anika Dy. As coaches, we come upon all kinds of athletes. We all have had those kids that put forth their maximum effort but may lack the skills to be outstanding in their sport. Or those that have the skills but lack the drive to be the best. Every once in a lifetime, a coach comes across that rare gift of ability and drive. Anika is that rare gift. And to top it off, she maintains a high GPA despite missing so much school for golf. Her stats speak for themselves. She won all 11 tournaments in which she participated, averaged 69.1 in scoring, 14.5 greens in regulation, shot over par only twice, had only 4 double bogeys all year, and won the state finals tournament for the third straight year. Many times Anika would go over to the driving range at 7am to get her practice time in before school. And although her statistics are outstanding, it's Anika's demeanor on the course that really makes her super. She combines confidence, control, composure and class that other players see and emulate. Competitors that play with Anika always comment on how encouraging, supportive and nice she is to them. Players and coaches together comment on how positive she is and how thankful she is to have played with them, not the other way around. However, the trait that makes Anika the champion she has become is humility. You never know from her demeanor whether she shot a 68 or 108 (which definitely wouldn't happen). Following this year's Invitational at Currie West in Midland, Anika came in after her round, handed in her card, sat down and started some homework, not saying a word that she had just shot a course record 63. Others usually make more of her accomplishments than she does. As a member of the National Honor Society, she volunteers often at school and community events. When she isn't playing or working on her game, she is giving back to it. Anika has completed arguably the greatest high school career in Michigan High School Girls Golf. She has set the bar high for future competitors. And although this chapter of her golf life is over, there are many chapters ahead, including her next challenge at the University of Michigan. We are looking forward to that challenge and are all better people having been a part of her high school career.



12 Alissa Fish **Brooklyn Columbia Central** Mike Jordon Alissa's career in high school golf is impressive but she is also an outstanding all around athlete and student. Alissa also found the time to maintain a high GPA while taking advance placement classes and was National Honor Society member. Her volunteer work included PLANK (peer to peer support group) and Brooklyn Buddies (working with elementary students). Alissa was named player of the year in Jackson County 2016, 2017 and 2018. She has finished as a runner up for the Miss Golf award three out of four years and made the Super Team those seasons as well. She has averaged just over 72 all three of those years, with her senior year being the best with a 72.10 18-hole avg and 34.88 9-hole avg. She finished runner up for the individual state championship her sophomore and senior year, both times to her future college teammate. Of her ten 18-hole rounds this season, she was the medalist seven times and shot sub-par rounds in half of those events, with her best score of 3-under 68 at the teams second league event. She was also named Female golfer of the Year by the Detroit Free Press. All of these accolades helped launch her into the #1 ranking in Michigan during the summer of 2018. While being an all around excellent golfer, Mikaela is an even better person and teammate. She has been on the National Honor Society for three years now and made Honorable Mention Academic All-State her senior year. Her hard work and motivation rub off in such a positive way on her teammates and those around her. She is often the first at practice and the last to leave. She is constantly helping teammates to improve their game, whether it be giving swing tips/thoughts or talking to them about the mental side of golf. Mikaela is often seen thanking volunteers for helping at events and coaches for hosting them. 


